*Interlocutor of the
Lord Lyon King of Arms

the Petition of*

*SIR NORMAN MURRAY ARCHIBALD MACGREGOR PRINGLE OF THAT ILK and of
STITCHEL, Baronet, CHIEF OF THE NAME AND ARMS OF THE HONOURABLE CLAN
PRINGLE (formerly Norman Murray Archibald MacGregor Pringle), etc*

of date 4 October 2018

Edinburgh, 28 May 2020. The Lord Lyon King of Arms, having considered the foregoing Petition and arguments for the Petitioner, **(Primo)** RECOGNISES the Petitioner in the name, style and dignity of SIR NORMAN MURRAY ARCHIBALD MACGREGOR PRINGLE OF THAT ILK, BARONET, CHIEF OF THE NAME AND ARMS OF PRINGLE for aught yet seen; and **(Secundo)** GRANTS WARRANT to the Lyon Clerk to prepare Letters Patent maintaining, ratifying and confirming to the Petitioner and his heirs bearing the name of Pringle of that Ilk the following Ensigns Armorial *videlicet*: Argent, on a bend Sable, three Escallops, Or; Above the Shield, which is environed of the badge pendent by its proper ribband of a Baronet of Nova Scotia, is placed an Helm befitting his degree with a mantling Sable doubled Argent, and on a Wreath of the Liveries is set for Crest an Escallop as the former, and in an Escrol over the same this motto “AMICITIA REDDIT HONORES”. On a compartment semée sprigs of elder leaves bearing the words “PRESSA EST INSIGNIS GLORIA FACTI” are set for Supporters dexter a deer proper,

and sinister a Grey-Hound Argent and collared Sable charged with Escallops Or, and upon a standard of four and a half yards in length parted in two Argent and Sable with the St Andrew's Cross in the hoist is depicted the Petitioner's said Crest three times in the fly with the motto "AMICITIA REDDIT HONORES" in letters Sable upon the transverse bands Or; and for Pinsel, four and a half feet long by two feet in height, Argent, upon a Wreath of Liveries Argent and Sable, bearing the Petitioner's said Crest within a strap Sable buckled and embellished Or, inscribed with the motto "AMICITIA REDDIT HONORES" Or, all within a circlet Or bearing the Petitioner's title "Pringle of that Ilk" Sable and in the fly an Escrol Sable bearing the slogan "Hoppryngill" Or with the clan plant badge a sprig of elder leaves; and (Tertio) officially recognises that, separately, the Petitioner is entitled to the name and arms of Pringle of Stichill and that the said ensigns armorial of Pringle of Stichill as recorded in Volume 1 of the Public Register of All Arms and Bearings in Scotland should be depicted within the said Letters Patent; And Grants Warrant to the Lyon Clerk to matriculate the same in the Public Register of All Arms and Bearings in Scotland.
